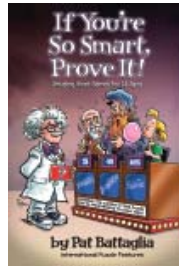




Dr. Fun's Word Fun Presentations

Description

The presentation was developed for church, civic and senior groups that enjoy playing amusing word games. The puzzles were selected from the following four books written by the presenter: Are You Smart, or What?, So You Think You're Smart, If You're So Smart, Prove It! and Smart Is as Smart Does. The presentation is given by the author in his Dr. Fun stereotypical rocket scientist costume that is reminiscent of his former career in rocketry at an aerospace company.



The presentation is interactive; games are read aloud by the author and attendees chime in with their answers. All brain teasers are extremely short, uncomplicated and easy to understand. They are highly clever and often have surprising and/or amusing answers. Jokes are sprinkled throughout the presentation to provide additional smiles and laughs. Besides the enjoyment, the puzzles help boost thinking skills and sharpen memory and concentration.

The talk begins with the author relating information about his exciting career in rocketry during the time when the U.S. was developing rockets for a moon landing. He also relates and how his Dr. Fun persona got started.
